
Bring yours to share and compare. Real paper or digital formats

There were 19 attendees for the meeting.


	HAM OF THE YEAR2014 NOMINATION

The 2014 ARRL 160 Meter Contest Will Warm Up Your Chilly December

The <u>ARRL 160 Meter Contest</u> -- an all-CW event -- is tremendous fun! As the object of the contest is for DX stations to contact American and Canadian stations (and vice versa), everyone will be seeking *you* (especially if you live in a rare section like North Dakota, Nebraska or any of the rare sections from November's Sweepstakes contests).

In this contest, Alaska (KL7) and Hawaii (KH6) count as DX, as do the Caribbean US possessions (KP1-KP5) and all of the Pacific Ocean territories (KH0-KH9). Even if you don't have an antenna for 160, you should just load up whatever you have through an antenna tuner and give "top band" a try -- even a 40 meter dipole through a tuner will make QSOs.

Since ARRL and RAC Sections are worth 2 points each *and* count as multipliers, the ARRL 160 Meter Contest is a good way to begin working -- or finishing up! -- your Worked All States (<u>WAS</u>) award. But don't forget about those DX stations -- each DXCC entity is a multiplier and is worth 5 points each.

The ARRL 160 Meter Contest runs from 2200 UTC Friday, December 5 through 1559 UTC Sunday, December 7. Logs must be e-mailed or postmarked no later than 1600 UTC Tuesday, January 6, 2015. Paper logs should be sent to ARRL 160 Meter Contest, 225 Main St, Newington, CT 06111. Email entries only to: 160meter@arrl.org.

The K7RA Solar Update

12/05/2014

Average daily sunspot numbers rose substantially over the past week, from 97.4 in the previous seven days to 152 for the most recent. Average daily solar flux rose from 168.9 to 172.1.

Predicted solar flux is currently 150 on December 5-6, 145 on December 7, 140 on December 8-12, 180 on December 13-14, 185 on December 15-19, 170 on December 20-23, 175 on December 24-27, 180 on December 28-30, 170 on December 31 through January 1, then 165, 160, 170 and 175 on January 2-5, and 180 on January 6-10.

Predicted planetary A index is 5 on December 5-12, 20 on December 13, 10 on December 14-15, then 8, 10 and 12 on December 16-18, 10 on December 19-20, 8 on December 21, 5 on December 22-27, then 15 and 12 on December 28-29, 8 on December 30-31, and 5 on January 1-6.
